## EMERGENCY PROCLAMATION – CURFEW

WHEREAS, a Declaration of Emergency has been executed pursuant to Chapter 11 of the City Code of the City of Jefferson; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 11 of the City Code authorizes the Mayor to exercise certain exceptional powers due to an emergency, including the authority to govern the City by proclamation; and

NOW, THEREFORE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH Chapter 11 of the City Code I, Carrie Tergin, Mayor, hereby proclaim the following:

1. All areas of the City of Jefferson within the geographical limits described herein (the “Curfew Area”) shall be under an order of curfew starting May 23, 2019 at 9:00 p.m., and continuing until May 24 at 5:00 a.m.

2. The Curfew Area shall consist of the following:

An area bounded on the east by Lafayette Street, on the south by Stadium Boulevard, on the west by Madison Street, on the north by the Missouri river. (Map attached)

3. For subsequent nights after the night of May 23, 2019, the Chief of Police may reinstitute this curfew on a nightly basis. The Chief of Police may reduce the Curfew Area in his discretion. If this curfew is reinstated by the Chief of Police, he is directed to provide as much advance notice to the public as is deemed possible and appropriate under the circumstances. Notwithstanding anything herein to the contrary, the authority delegated to the Chief of Police herein shall expire on Tuesday, May 28, 2019 at 5:00 a.m. unless extended by further emergency proclamation.

4. This curfew shall require all persons who are not exempt by Paragraph 5 below or other law to remove themselves from any public way, public street or public place within the Curfew Area during the curfew.

5. The following individuals shall be exempt from the requirement of this curfew: individuals engaged in providing designated, essential services, such as fire, law enforcement, public works, municipal code enforcement, emergency medical and hospital services, military, and utility/telecommunications emergency repairs. This curfew shall also not apply to employees of local industries traveling to and from their jobs with appropriate identification, news media employees, or building and repair contractors and their employees performing activities related to construction, repair, renovation or improvement of buildings and other structures damaged during the emergency.

6. All law enforcement officials of the City of Jefferson and other jurisdictions duly providing aid within the City of Jefferson are empowered to enforce the terms of this curfew order.

7. The local emergency management coordinator and other officials or employees of the

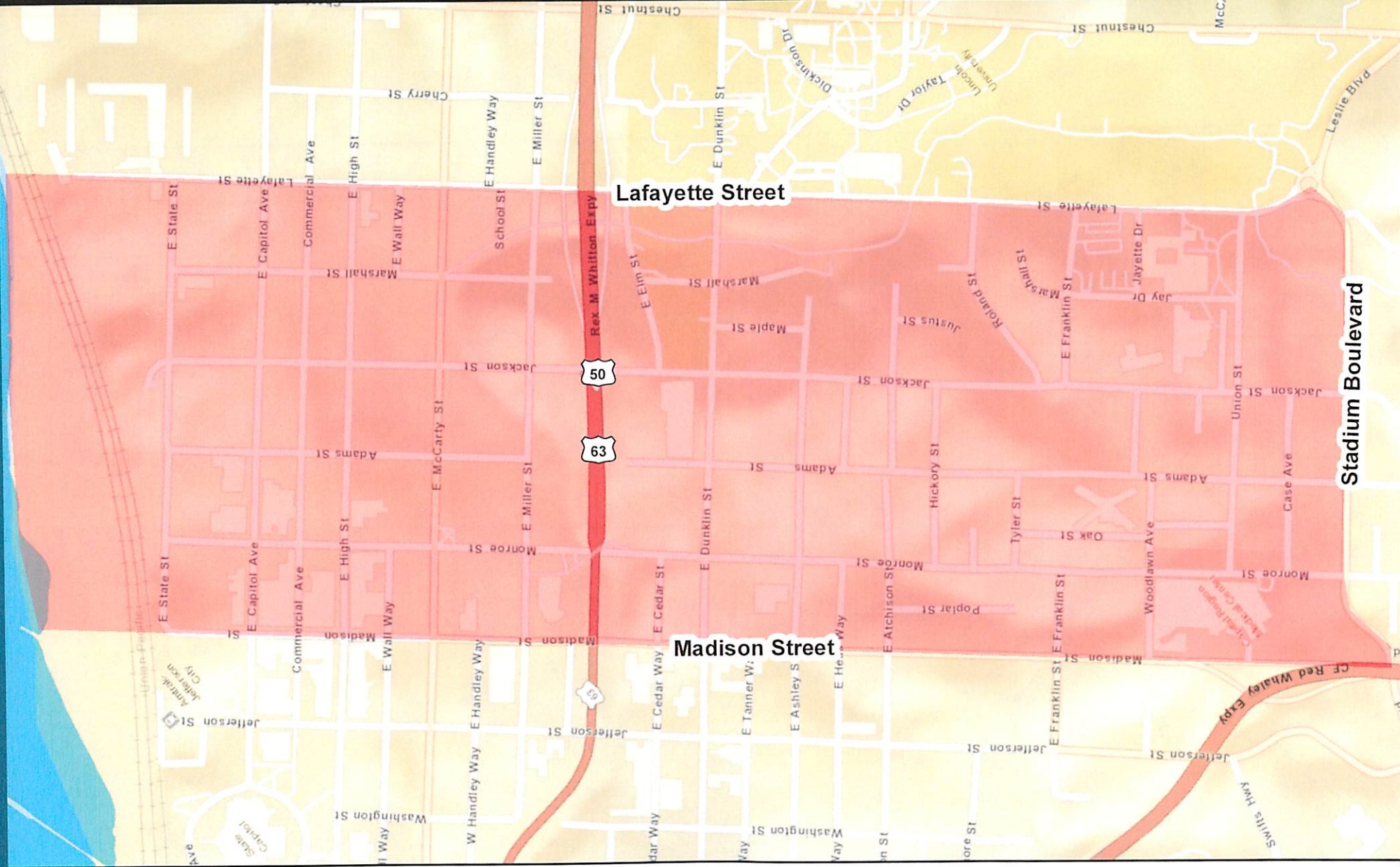
municipality may assist in implementing this curfew order or any curfew order issued pursuant to state or federal authority.
